Youth Ministry Code of Conduct

THE GOAL. All of our actions, attitudes, and relationships will display a life consistent with that of a follower of Jesus Christ.

PARTICIPATION. We expect full participation in all scheduled and group activities of the trip or event, including meals, meetings, small groups, etc.

MATURITY AND MODESTY. We expect maturity and modesty from all participants in words, language, relationships, actions, and dress.

RESPECT. We expect respect from all participants in three areas:

- * in relationships with one another.
- * toward any adult youth leader.
- * toward our environment and surroundings.

THE OBVIOUS. We expect this to be perfectly clear:

- * Sexual indiscretion is prohibited in all cases.
- * Absolutely **NO** alcohol, tobacco products of **ANY** kind, illegal drugs, weapons or fireworks will be bought, brought, possessed, used, or acquired in any way.

ACCOUNTABILITY PROCESS. We follow a three-step process of accountability:

- * A private phone call will take place between the youth, youth leader, and parents as to the circumstances and accountability.
- * The course of action may include reprimands and restrictions up to and including leaving the trip/event.
 - * Final decisions are in the discretion of the trip/event leader.
